Collars and Leashes: Per BHA rules, electronic collars/devices are not allowed anywhere on the site; this includes electronic bark collars. Head halters are also not allowed at BH Fun Tests or Trials.

Dogs MUST run "naked", without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring. Refer to Barn Hunt Association Rules and Regulations, Page 5, Section 3. FUN TEST, letter g) regarding collar/harness and leash in a Fun Test.

Food is available within 5 miles of the venue Crating is outside or out of cars Blinds will be at least 10x20 and covered outdoors Masters blinds will be 4 dogs

Refunds: No refunds after closing date except with a vet or doctor note.

Camping: No camping on the grounds.

Bitches in Season: Bitches in season (BIS) **MAY** compete in this event. They will run at the end of each class. BIS must wear pants at all times when not being pottied, including on the course. Owners of BIS should seek out one of the Committee members upon arrival so that you can be directed to the designated parking and walking area. Advance notice to the secretary is greatly appreciated if you will be bringing a BIS! Failure to notify the secretary and fellow competitors will result in dismissal from the show grounds.
